

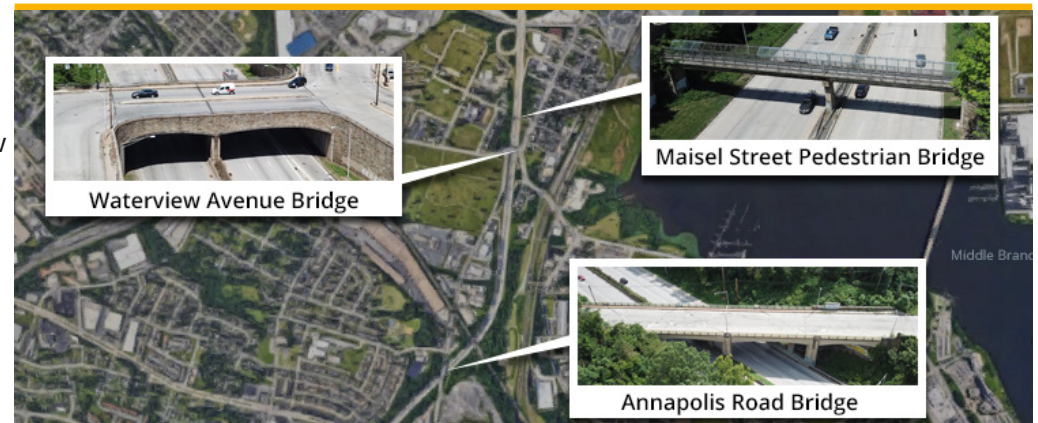
The 295 Triple Bridges Project will replace the Annapolis Road, Maisel Street, and Waterview Avenue bridges over MD 295 from 2019 through 2023.

The project will include:

- Replacement of 3 bridges with similar structures
- Addition of an auxiliary lane on MD 295
- Modifications to the on/off ramps at Waterview Ave
- Removal of existing abandoned railroad tunnel and replaced with retaining wall
- Sign replacement on MD 295 from Bush Street to the City/County line
- Resurfacing of Annapolis Road from Patapsco Avenue to the Waterview Avenue bridge

The project features the following enhancements:

- New substructures will match the existing stone walls
- Added 2 feet of walkway width on the Maisel Street pedestrian bridge and artistic bridge fencing
- 10 foot wide sidewalk on the north side of the Waterview Avenue bridge and decorative railings
- Decorative light poles and railings on the Annapolis Road bridge
- Complete pedestrian Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades



Waterview Avenue Bridge

The Waterview Avenue bridge will be constructed in phases with traffic maintained throughout construction, with the exception of a few weekend closure periods, detours will be in place. In order to keep pedestrian crossings available for pedestrians east of MD 295, the north half of the Waterview Avenue bridge (including the 10 foot sidewalk) will be reconstructed before the Maisel Street pedestrian bridge is closed.

Maisel Street Pedestrian Bridge

The Maisel Street pedestrian bridge will be closed in the later half of the project for approximately 10 months. There will be a detour for pedestrians utilizing the newly constructed Waterview Avenue bridge sidewalk.

Annapolis Road Bridge

The Annapolis Road bridge will be closed for approximately 2 years during the project as it is reconstructed.

295 Impacts

Two lanes of vehicular traffic each way on MD 295 in the construction zone will be maintained throughout the duration of the project as inside and outside lanes will be closed periodically. The Waterview Avenue ramp to Northbound MD 295 will be closed for approximately 3.5 years and the Annapolis Road ramp to Southbound MD 295 will be closed for approximately 1.5 years, with detours.
